

## SPAWNER SALMON SURVEYS - FALL 2019

2 Salmon species were observed - Chum and Coho.

14 Creeks were surveyed by 21 Creek Monitors.

The fish numbers were down considerably compared to the count of 260 in 2018.

There were very poor returns in most of the creeks outside the Brothers watershed.

2019 would traditionally be a Pink Salmon year, but none were observed.

Disappointing as these results are, most of the south coast suffered a sharp decline in the chum salmon return in 2019, with the Fraser River having the lowest return year recorded since 1995.
